



black river, cosmic black or even a volcanic rock to create a stunning feature. Cooking has become a huge part of the modern lifestyle so putting professional-style appliances at the very top end will achieve that 'cuisine experience' at home. Most buyers are guided and reassured by big-name brands and the latest gadgets."

In today's competitive climate, anything that makes a kitchen stand out will draw the crowds. Cabinetry with inlaid leather and patterned metal details have the edge over simple high-gloss designs. "The role of the designer is to open developers' eyes to the tactile textures and amazing finishes they never knew existed," adds Weiss. "We guide developers through the design process, preventing them from making mistakes."

to what today's buyers want. Many clients are well travelled with greater expectations than ever before and a desire to own a statement kitchen with real star quality. Many designs will now incorporate intelligent features, mood-enhancing lighting and the latest in wireless sound systems for the complete package.

Location is also key, as Peter Allen, sales and marketing director at Londonewcastle, explains. "For us, it's not a case of allocating the same fixed portion of an overall budget to the kitchen," he says. "Rather, it is about looking at the positioning of the development – its location, value and the customer we are aiming at. We also keep in touch with the market by attending design shows in London and abroad, such as Salone del Mobile in Milan, to gain an insight into new products and trends. It's important to create interiors

with character but they also need to be timeless, to some extent, because we often specify finishes in larger developments two years before the buyers move in."

Craig Matson, managing director of Roundhouse kitchens, is a trained architect and says that developers and their architects and designers will often look to a single source rather than individual product suppliers to deliver the kitchen, forming a long-established relationship over time. Some of these suppliers include SieMatic, Poggenpohl, Bulthaup and Boffi, while architect Paul Archer finds that the key elements tend to be light, openness and sociability. "If we're talking really high spec," he laughs, "we will often end up with two kitchens - one for the staff, who do the real cooking, and one for the family, which may just be for breakfast and light prep." 9
